- Please provide detailed information and where applicable, provide specific examples.
- Provide a one-page (or less) letter of reference from someone other than the nominator that speaks specifically to the criteria/guidelines referenced above.
- Please do not attach photos or any additional documentation other than the letter of reference to the nomination form.
